At least 8 instruments must be used, (live) electronics are desired. String quintet, Flute I, Oboe I, Clarinet I, Bassoon I, Horn I, Trumpet I, Trombone I, Tuba I

DURATION OF THE COMPOSITION

4-30 minutes
